When you have found a GP practice you like, you can formally register with it as an NHS patient by submitting a registration form to them, available from the surgery.

Some GP practices may ask for proof of identity when you register, such as a passport or driving licence, especially when you register children in your care. This may be used to check your details match with the information held on the NHS central patient registry and that your previous medical notes are passed on to the new practice.

The NHS will then transfer your medical records to your new practice and write to you to confirm your registration as a patient with that practice.
